



BLACKJACK LANE *Equestrian*

Barn Rules

The following procedures and regulations are provided to insure the safety, pleasure, security and wellbeing of clients, client horses, and others using facilities at Blackjack Lane Equestrian.

1. Barn hours are 7:00am-10:00pm. If you need to come to the facility during off hours, you must inform trainer that you will be on the premises.
2. A release must be signed before working with or mounting any horse.
3. Any minor under the age of 18 years must wear an ASTM Certified Riding Helmet while riding. Those over the age of 18 may elect to not wear a helmet (though strongly discouraged) while on the flat. Jumping lessons require a helmet for all participants regardless of age.
4. Jumping is only permitted under the supervision of a trainer (i.e. during lessons). No exceptions. Those who violate this rule will **immediately have their boarding or lesson contract terminated**.
 - a. Riders are allowed to hack over poles or mountain poles (3 poles stacked horizontally in a pyramid fashion with 2 on the bottom and one on top) if they are already accessible.
 - b. No one is allowed to move or change jumps, standards, poles or the like unless they directly affect someone's safety.
5. Anyone under 13 must have an adult person responsible in attendance for this child's actions at all times.
6. No mounting or riding of horse inside barns or ranch barns.
7. NO SMOKING in or near the barn.
8. Lunge only in designated areas unless weather does not permit (i.e. wet conditions).
9. All dogs MUST be leashed.
10. Everyone is required to clean up after your horse (i.e. manure, hoof pickings, mane pulling waste).
11. Turn off water after use.
12. No use of farm equipment (i.e. tractors) is permitted by clients.
13. Keep all gates closed and latched.
14. Always use a lead rope when moving your horse.
15. All lessons are to be scheduled with trainer. No outside trainers are allowed unless they are scheduled clinicians scheduled by resident trainer.

16. Any damage done to the barn, stalls or the like by client's horse will be repaired at the horse owner's expense. Horses that crib or chew wood may be required to wear a cribbing strap or muzzle at the owner's expense.
17. Horse owners shall not hold Blackjack Lane Equestrian LLC., Krissan Barber, Adam Barber or any staff of Blackjack Lane Equestrian LLC, liable for damages or loss of personal property, saddle, tack, equipment or vehicle stored on the property or parked on the property, due to any cause, including but not limited to: fire, storm, vandalism, theft, birds, cats, etcetera, and acknowledges that it is the sole responsibility of the horse owner to carry insurance on these articles of property.
18. Insurance on horses boarded is the sole responsibility of the horse owner.
19. Speed limit is 5mph for everyone on farm.
20. Riding alone is discouraged, but if you must, please carry your cell phone with you.
21. If a horse is deemed dangerous, the trainer has the right to ask the owner to remove the horse from the property and terminate the boarding and/or training contract.
22. Tack trunks are welcome in front of your stall.
23. Closed toe shoes are required if handling a horse or entering their stall. No exceptions.
24. Do not use anyone else's tack without permission, whether Blackjack Lane Equestrian LLC. or fellow boarders'.
25. Do not leave horses unattended in crossties.
26. Do not swim or play in ponds.
27. Any adults or children that accompany you and/or your child to the barn from this day forward, are your sole responsibility. By signing below, you agree that they are also in understanding of these rules, and will not hold Blackjack Lane Equestrian responsible for any injury, or damage to themselves.

I understand and agree to adhere to the above procedures and regulations. I also understand that if I violate these rules, my horse and I may be asked to leave Blackjack Lane Equestrian.
