Lesson Program Agreement

I,	agree to the following in order for myself
my child or children to be a part of the Blackjack	Lane Equestrian LLC. Lesson program on
tuition.	

- 1. I understand that monthly tuition is broken down to include holiday closures and sick/vacation days for a calendar year. Due to this, I understand there are no guaranteed makeup days.
- 2. I understand that I will not be allowed to ride until my tuition is paid.
- 3. I agree to notify Blackjack Lane if I will be missing my lesson so that accommodations can be made, if needed, to exercise and/or groom the horse/pony that I/my child was assigned.
- 4. I understand that if I know I will miss a lesson due to a vacation or prior engagement, communicating with the staff *may* allow me/my child to attend a lesson on a different day but realize this is <u>ONLY</u> if there is space in an appropriate lesson and a horse/pony of appropriate skill level is available to do so. <u>The ability to change my lesson is not guaranteed and is at the sole discretion of Blackjack Lane Equestrian.</u>
- 5. On the tuition program, I know my spot is saved in my assigned lesson group or times slot but that lesson time may need to be adjusted slightly due to staffing availability, horse shows, etc.
- 6. I am aware that weather cancellations do not warrant any makeup lessons and that Blackjack Lane Equestrian will only utilize cancellations in extreme conditions.
- 7. I understand that not all lessons will be mounted and that Blackjack Lane Equestrian LLC holds the right to decide which lessons are mounted and which lessons are in the barn, office, classroom or other setting.
- 8. I am aware that I/my child need to be on time to our lesson.
 - a. Lessons do not run over if I am late. For beginner private lessons, we may finish the lesson as a barn lesson or my ride time will be reduced.
 - b. I understand that I will be asked to forfeit my group lesson if I am over 10 minutes late to the arena. I understand that this is to ensure both horse and rider have adequate warm up time which reduce the risk of injury and to ensure that the rest of the lesson is not held back due to my tardiness.
- 9. I agree to give a 60-day notice to cancel our riding lessons with Blackjack Lane Equestrian LLC. and understand I will be responsible for paying tuition fees for the 60 days following notice regardless of attendance.
 - a. The only exception to this is moving to a training package when the rider begins a lease or purchases a horse.
