Blackjack Show Circuit Rules and Guidelines

- Entries: Please submit entries online at <u>www.HorseShowsOnline.com</u>. Please be sure to include the USHJA number when doing your entries to ensure you receive USHJA points. Entries are due Wednesday, January 17th.
- Memberships:
 - Membership with Blackjack Show Circuit is required if you wish to qualify for end of the year awards, and for USHJA Affiliate National Championship qualification. Memberships are for the current show year only.
 - Fees: \$15 per rider per year \$15 per horse per year
 - Membership with USHJA Outreach is required if you wish to have your points tracked for rewards and awards from USHJA. Membership applications can be done online or printed and mailed with payment to USHJA.
 - Fees: Riders are FREE Horse: Annual \$20 or Lifetime \$75

- Coggins: proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. Proof of vaccination for flu/rhino within the last 6 months also required by Blackjack Lane Equestrian. Paperwork may be emailed prior or can be brought to the show office the day of. Horses will not be permitted to be unloaded until these documents are in hand.
- Waivers: <u>all riders and all visitors must sign the online waiver form</u>. All riders, trainers and spectators in attendance acknowledge that horses can be dangerous and riding horses is an inherently dangerous sport. Please keep an eye on children and do not enter any pastures, personal or client areas of Blackjack Lane Equestrian.
- Arenas: the main arena is 110'x250' with sandy loam footing. The outdoor arena is 100'x155' with sand footing.
- Division Eligibility: junior divisions are for riders 17 years and younger as of December 1, 2023. Adult Amateur Divisions: riders 18 years and older that are NOT equine professionals. Open Divisions open to ALL riders, including professionals.
- Cross Entries: a horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter into Open Walk Trot Crossrails.
- Divisions: divisions must have a minimum of 3 riders COMPLETE the classes in order to be eligible for points.
- Awards: All classes will receive ribbons first through sixth place unless otherwise noted. A champion prize and ribbon and a reserve champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.
- Attire: proper show attire is required. Jackets may be waived and polos accepted for shows June-August. No half chaps allowed. Helmets must be properly fastened and must be worn at all times by riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.
- Dogs: NO OUTSIDE DOGS ALLOWED. We love dogs, but unfortunately cannot allow outsides dogs on the property. No exceptions.
- Concessions: will be available during show hours. There are also lots of restaurants nearby.
- Split Classes: all classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries, will be split.
- Management reserves the right to combine or scratch classes/divisions
- Blackjack Show Circuit may use the USEF Rulebook for any issues that arise.
